Updated Prioritized Trail Projects

(Note: this list is not necessarily the order that projects will be addressed. Other factors will come into consideration).

- 1. Sinks Improve between sharp left hairpin and 3 benches. Reroute where necessary.
- 2. Keith's trail a quarter mile past chestnut (i.e. last decent before creek crossing) Reroute around rocky fall line.
- 3. Dummyline Trail maintenance
- 4. Bankhead Trail polishing
- 5. Logan's Pt. bench cut entry and exit. Work on turns and add berms.
- 6. Dropping in to Mountain Mist from O'Shaghnessy point 100 'section is badly eroded
- 7. Dummyline to Hightrail (new trail)
- 8. Barricade to mountain mist (new trail)
- 9. Mountain Mist Improve the transition between the rerouted railroad tie steps section and the steep hill.
- 10. Alternate route from Bluffline to High trail (new trail)
- 11. Small general maintenance on top trails
- 12. Dummyline to Cold Springs (new trail)
- 13. Rocky Friggin Nightmare
